## COVID-19 Information to Members – April 30, 2021

Dear Member

Great News! Most Restrictions have been lifted!

**Premier Mark McGowan has announced most restrictions will be lifted as at 12:01am on Saturday 1 May 2021.**

What does this mean for the Club?

- Rimondo's is back to full dining activities - masks must be worn in the Members Lounge while moving around. Masks can be removed while seated and you are consuming beverages or meals;
- The 2sqm rule is back in place for food and beverage; and
- Mandatory check-in using the SAFEWA App still applies on Club grounds (please note you only need to check in once each time you visit the Club – whether this be in the Clubhouse or out on the jetty).

**From midnight tomorrow night, most restrictions in Perth & Peel will be lifted**

At 12:01am, Saturday 1 May, most restrictions will return to pre-lockdown conditions.  
Some minor transitional restrictions will remain in place for seven days (until 12:01am, Saturday 8 May)

**Masks**  
Masks will still be required:  
■ in public indoor spaces (including public transport and workplaces), and  
■ in public outdoor settings where it isn't possible to physically distance (eg. at events).  
Masks will no longer be required in public while outdoors, provided it is possible to physically distance from others.  
Use common sense and take a mask with you whenever you leave home.  
Exemptions will continue to apply, including for people with certain disabilities and children in primary school or younger.  
These requirements also apply to anyone in other regions who has been in Perth or Peel since 17 April.

**Gatherings**  
30  
Private gatherings at homes will be limited to 30 people, as masks are not required at home.  
Outdoor gatherings return to previous conditions, with COVID event plans required for large events.

**Businesses & venues**  
OPEN  
All businesses and venues can open.  
Most businesses and venues can return to the capacity that they had before lockdown, except for nightclubs (4 sqm capacity rule applied).  
Perth's major stadiums can operate at 75 per cent capacity, with masks required.

**Community Sport & Fitness**  
Indoor fitness venues, dance studios and gyms can reopen, noting mask requirements.  
Indoor and outdoor community sport may resume with spectators.

**Health and Aged Care**  
All elective surgeries will resume.  
Patient visits are allowed with visitors from one household per patient per day in hospital or aged/disability care.

**Education**  
Universities can resume in-person learning.  
Masks required for staff at all schools, and for students in secondary schools.  
Teachers may remove masks while conducting a class.

As we ease restrictions, it is vital that we all keep using the SafeWA app & getting tested if unwell.
