1 Rules

The event will be sailed under the Time Trialling Rules 2021 Revision 2.2 (as amended from time to time) of the CPYA, here in after referred to as the Rules and these Sailing Instructions. The Rules are applicable at the event starting time and as modified by these Sailing Instructions or the arrival of the start boat or checkpoint boat at station whichever is the earlier. 2 Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available on the website from mid early April 2026.
The sailing instructions will be sent by email to registered competitors on or before 17 April 2026
Hard copies of the sailing instructions will be available in the PFSYC office from early April 2026.

3 Communication

All boats must have at least one of the following means of communication;

- Radio communication will be by VHF Channel 68
- Mobile Phone

All boats are encouraged to have their radios on to assist in management of the race. Where radio contact is not possible, telephone contact with race officials can be made on **0420 383 332 (Start Box)**.

4 Eligibility & Entry

The event is open to all power boats.

Navigation lights must be in working order and used after sunset along with a decent spotlight. Regulations around navigation lights and navigation safety can be found at [Lights required on boats \(transport.wa.gov.au\)](http://transport.wa.gov.au) and [Night navigation \(transport.wa.gov.au\)](http://transport.wa.gov.au)

Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form to members@pfsyc.com.au by 5pm on Tuesday 14 April 2026.

5 Start Time & Finish Line

Will be as per course sheet and in accordance with Definition Part II of the Rules. Notification of any change of course shall be in accordance with Clause 15.5 of the Rules.

6 Course Details & Start Times

Will be provided to each competitor via email.

For any discrepancy between the Course List and Course Maps the Course List takes precedence.

7 Venue

The race will start and finish at the Perth Flying Squadron Yacht Club.

8 Scoring & Handicaps

This event is based on the least number of accumulated points inclusive of any applied penalties (least points).

9 Risk Statement

Neither the Cruising & Power Yacht Association nor the host club nor any officer or official of the aforesaid committee association or club shall be responsible for any personal injury or damage to property arising from any cause whatsoever. Participating in the event shall be deemed an acceptance of this indemnity. However, any accident involving personal injury or damage to property howsoever arising shall be reported immediately to the Regatta Control Officer or a member of the Organising Committee.

10 Insurance

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.

11 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded following the race in the Mele Bilo Room.
