Participation Agreement

The dictionary definition of a "Club" is an organisation of people with a common purpose or interest, who meet regularly and take part in shared activities.

Further to this, the principal objects of the Club as defined in our Constitution are stated as:

- To establish, maintain and conduct a Club that:
 - Encourages and supports a wide range of recreational, boating and aquatic sporting activities and offer programs in sail training, racing, cruising, time trialing, youth development and seamanship.
 - To foster orderly boating, recreational and social events and gatherings of boat owners and their friends, with particular emphasis on family and community involvement in aquatic sporting activities.

Being a Member of the Perth Flying Squadron Yacht Club is a privilege and carries with it a responsibility to uphold the Club's reputation and to regularly participate in the Club's events and competitions.

All new Ordinary, Family, Country and Boat Affiliate Members are required to participate in a minimum of one (1) Flag event per financial year to maintain their Membership. Failure to participate in one Flag event each year will result in the General Committee reviewing your Membership. The Committee, after hearing the evidence, may inflict a penalty of suspension or expulsion from any or all of the privileges of membership in accordance with clause 27 of the Club's Constitution.

Parmelia Night Regatta Race

- Invitational Regatta Race held in Summer which covers most of the river. This Flag Event is held on a Friday evening during summer and attracts yachts from most other Clubs. Yachts sail around the river, passing checkpoint marks along the way. Lots of Prizes up for grabs.

Checkpoint Duty for Parmelia Night Race

- Power boat members can participate in this Flag Event by being on checkpoint duty for the Parmelia Night Race. This involves anchoring up at an allocated spot on the river and recording the time the yacht passes your point.

Glenys & Wally Pickford Memorial Marathon Race

- Invitational Regatta Race named after Past Commodore Wally Pickford. This marathon is held in Summer and covers most of the river and is one the Club's most prestigious Flag Events attracting yachts from most other Clubs. Lots of Prizes up for grabs.

Opening Day Regatta Race

- Invitational Regatta Race held on the Opening Day of our Sailing Season. Held on the first Sunday in November this is always a great afternoon out on the water racing with Members from our Club and other Yacht Clubs. Flags & prizes awarded to Fastest Time, First, Second & Third Place in Division 1 & 2, and First, Second & Third Place Division 3 & 4.

Cork Evans Power Boat Time Trial

- Power Boat Time Trial held in Winter. A test of accuracy rather than concentrating on speed. Boats are required to arrive at a checkpoint at precisely the right time, based on your nominated speed which can range from 8 to 15 knots. A one-point penalty is applied for every second that a boat is early or late at each checkpoint. Your team will comprise of a skipper and a navigator and is a great way to give your boat a run over the winter months. Flags & prizes awarded to First Place, Second Place & Third Place with many door prizes also up for grabs for those who participate.

Checkpoint Duty for Cork Evans Time Trial

- Members can volunteer their time to be on checkpoint duty for the Cork Evans Time Trial. This involves anchoring up on an allocated spot on the river and recording the time the power boat passes your point.

Rottnest Navigation & Raft Up

- A convoy to Rottnest to learn about the bays and participate in competitions along the way, ending with a raft up.
